THE DRAWING: INSTRUMENTS AND SUPPORTS One day classes

In one day, plunged in the beautiful landscapes of the Sienese hills near San Galgano, and assisted by a fine art master, you will learn the secrets of the ancient writing and the skill of preparing ancient inks by yourselves using natural materials.



Main objectives:

- Learning the rudiments of various handwriting techniques by using: silver points on dyed rag paper, reeds on original papyrus, goose-quills on animal skin parchment, oak gall metal ink, charcoal and red crayon on prepared pasteboard.
- You will learn different methods for preparing drawing supports for ancient drawings.
- Preparation of original and peculiar metal inks used in ancient times.



Contents:

- Theoretical and practical lessons on how to draw on papyrus, parchment, dyed paper and charcoal supports.
- Preparation of metal ink using oak gall nuts found in the local forests of durmast oaks and oak-trees.
- Practical lessons and preparation of the supports used in ancient handwriting techniques, such as prepared papers and parchments.
- Rudiments of the methods of preparation of goose-quills used in ancient times to write on parchments.
